



### What Is Osteoarthritis?

#### **OSTEOARTHRITIS**

NORMAL HEALTHY KNEE JOINT

Osteoarthritis (OA) of the knee is a progressive, non-inflammatory degenerative joint disease characterized by the breakdown of the joint's cartilage. OA is the most common form of chronic arthritis, and is often a result of aging, a joint injury, repeated joint stress, a joint malformation, or a genetic defect in joint cartilage.



#### **OSTEOARTHRITIC KNEE JOINT**

#### **Normal Healthy knee joint**

Healthy cartilage allows bones to glide over one another and absorbs energy from the shock of physical movement.

#### **Osteoarthritic knee joint**

The surface layer of cartilage breaks down and wears away. Bone under the cartilage rubs together, causing pain, swelling, and loss of motion of the joint. Over time, the knee may lose its normal shape. Small deposits of bone, called bone spurs, may grow on the edges of the knee joint. These can break off and float inside the joint space, causing even more pain and damage.





## Knee Osteoarthritis

A HEALTHY KNEE



In a healthy knee, the ends of bones are covered with smooth cartilage and protected by a joint capsule filled with synovial fluid. Hyaluronic acid (HA) is naturally found in high concentrations in the synovial fluid and helps lubricate and cushion the knee, allowing the bones to glide smoothly against each other, and absorbing the shock and friction from physical movement.



#### **A KNEE WITH**

#### SEVERE OSTEOARTHRITIS

With osteoarthritis, the natural hyaluronic acid breaks down leaving lower concentrations of HA in the synovial fluid surrounding the knee.<sup>2</sup> The synovial fluid becomes less effective at cushioning, lubricating, and protecting the knee.<sup>2,3</sup> As a result, the cartilage covering the bones begins to deteriorate, and the unprotected bones rub together, causing pain, stiffness and decreased mobility.<sup>3</sup>

### **Osteoarthritis Treatment**

### TREATMENT APPROACHES TO OSTEOARTHRITIS

- » Exercise to keep strong and limber, improve cardiovascular fitness, extend your knees' range of motion, and reduce your weight
- » Weight control can reduce stress on the knee, limit further injury, and increase mobility
- » Rest and relief from stress on knee know when to stop or slow down to prevent pain caused by overexertion
- » Nondrug pain relief techniques including massage therapy, physical therapy, acupuncture and other alternative treatments
- » Medications to control pain to eliminate or reduce pain and to improve function
- » MONOVISC® is a single-injection hyaluronic acid treatment that significantly reduces knee pain for 6 months, improves physical function and protects the surface of articular cartilage<sup>3,4</sup>. MONOVISC can be administered by your physician.
- » Surgery to remove bone spurs and cartilage, reposition bones or perform a total knee replacement

# MONOVISC®



#### Indications

MONOVISC® is indicated as a viscoelastic supplement or a replacement for synovial fluid in human knee joints. MONOVISC is well suited for treatment of the symptoms of human knee joint dysfunctions such as osteoarthritis. The actions of MONOVISC are lubrication and mechanical support.


#### Side effects

Most common side effects are injection-site pain, burning, swelling or redness.

#### Contraindications

MONOVISC is composed of cross-linked sodium hyaluronate and may contain trace amounts of gram positive bacterial proteins. The following preexisting conditions may constitute relative or absolute contraindications to the use of MONOVISC:

- » Known sensitivity to any of the materials contained in MONOVISC
- » Pre-existing infections of the skin region of the intended injection site
- » Known infection of the index joint
- » Known systemic bleeding disorders
